FOLLOW UP: The Results of the FORM Pre-Spring 2008 Fashion Show

Almost **1 month** to the date, and here we are with the results of the **Form Pre-Spring 2008** show. Always a pleasure to take in a runway show that is *not actually* on a runway, as you never quite know what you're going to get. In the case of the **Form Pre -Spring 2008** show, what a *very select* crowd GOT was a *very private* glimpse of a very sexy come hither collection atop the **Rockefeller Center Roof Gardens** on one slightly balmy afternoon in **June**.

Classically Gothic beauties took to the narrow rooftop pathway (runway) wearing **silk rompers, and dresses, in pale icy hues of silver, cream, and white**. The influence was the flight like quality of a kite with several pieces complete with hanging strings-- i.e. **Sodomite Romper in Sky Blue** made of heavy satin (see first photo at far left). Standouts in the collection consisted of: **Rokakku Kite Top over Hot Pant (worn upside down)**, **Delta Kite Dress in Ivory Silk Charmeuse**, and a more traditional looking cocktail style dress--**Windsock Dress in Ash Knit**.

Soon after the models, which included **Lily Cole** among others, did a final drift from the garden pathway back through the roof top's entrance, the show was over. **Form Pre-Spring 2008** had a been a success. Pure **PERFECTION!** a clearly definable balance of light weight, fanciful dressing with a very minimalist futuristic edge. The collection was very clean, very crisp, very artistic--this is certainly a label to watch closely over time.
